2025 SACE Art Show puts students' creativity on display

The artistic passions and talents of over 130 students from across South Australia is currently being exhibited at the 2025 SACE Art Show, one of the largest secondary school art and design exhibitions in the state.

Identity, disconnection, body image, natural beauty, gaming, mental health, music, and more have all featured as themes in the creative expressions of the young artists.

The works of the 136 students exemplify the importance of art in education in providing opportunities for engagement and meaningful learning and offering young people the vehicle to highlight topics and issues that are important to them and to society at large.

Selected from 313 nominations, the works on display include paintings, drawings, sculptures, costumes and multimedia designs. Of these, nine students have received awards thanks to the generosity of sponsors.

Hosted by the SACE Board and TAFE SA, the SACE Art Show is supported by the Minister for Human Services, the Australian Education Union, Eckersley's Art and Craft, Flinders University, Adelaide Central School of Art and the Independent Education Union.

The Art Show is open to the public until April 10, at the Light Square Gallery (at the Adelaide College of the Arts, 39 Light Square, Adelaide).

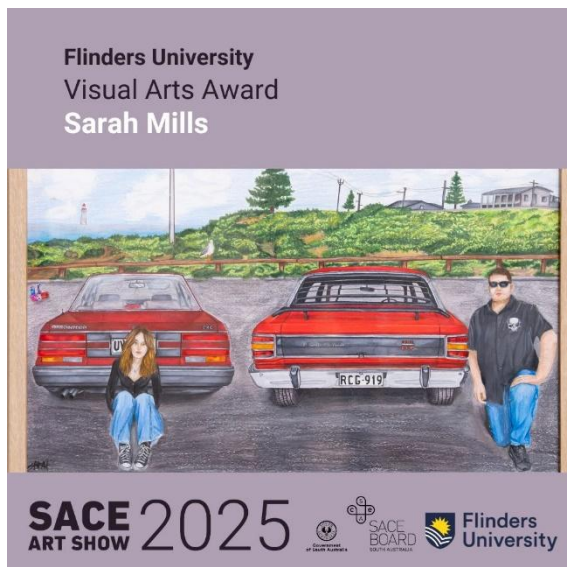
