

NTCET Completion Requirements

NTCET Curriculum Pattern

Students must achieve a minimum of 200 credits to complete their NTCET. These credits comprise of compulsory and non-compulsory requirements.

The compulsory requirements are:

- Exploring Identities and Futures (10 credits)
- Literacy (at least 20 credits) from a range of English subjects
- Numeracy (at least 10 credits) from a range of mathematics subjects
- SACE subjects and/or courses that the SACE Board recognises (at least 60 credits at Stage 2).

The non-compulsory requirements are:

- SACE subjects, Vocational Education and Training courses and/or recognised learning gained at Stage 1 or Stage 2 (at least 100 credits).

Students with disabilities that affect intellectual or adaptive abilities can choose from modified subjects that are designed to allow them to demonstrate their learning in a range of challenging and achievable learning experiences. Where students undertake Modified subjects, they will achieve a Modified NTCET.
