Accepted file names — Stage 2

The SACE Board has selected nine Stage 2 subjects for the online submission of assessment materials in 2017.

This information sheet outlines for teachers the file-naming convention to be used when submitting assessment materials in Schools Online.

When teachers submit assessment materials in Schools Online, they will need to follow a prescribed naming convention. Files that do not follow the naming convention will be rejected by Schools Online and will require re-naming and re-loading.

The prescribed file-naming conventions (outlined below) ensure that:

- teachers can upload materials individually and in bulk
- Schools Online can intelligently recognise the materials and automatically match them to students' SACE registration numbers.

The SACE Board strongly encourages teachers to request that students save their files using the following naming convention:

Seven character student SACE registration number, followed by dash.

Six character subject code, followed by a dash.

Three character assessment type code corresponding with assessment type numbering, as in subject outlines, followed by a dash.

100 character limit for free text used by the teacher to differentiate files, E.g. Task 3 Final Version.
