- A sudden drop in temperature
- The unnerving lull before the storm
- Wind speed increases
- Tree branches and leaves move loudly as the wind blows
- Objects start to get blown around
- The beginning of a rain storm
- Hail, thunder and lightening
- A calming down of the force of the storm
- A rainbow
- The clouds break
- Sunshine and calm

Once you have established a plan of events, this should influence the sequence of events within your own composition
