## NTCET Pattern

Students must achieve a minimum of 200 credits to complete their NTCET. These credits comprise of compulsory and non-compulsory requirements.

The compulsory requirements are:

- Exploring Identities and Futures (10 credits)
- Literacy (at least 20 credits) from a range of English subjects
- Numeracy (at least 10 credits) from a range of mathematics subjects
- SACE subjects and/or courses that the SACE Board recognises (at least 60 credits at Stage 2).

The non-compulsory requirements are:

- SACE subjects, vocational education and training (VET) courses and/or recognised learning gained at Stage 1 or 2 (at least 100 credits).

To gain an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR), students are required to successfully complete 90 credits of Stage 2 Tertiary Admissions Subjects as indicated by the dotted line on the diagram.
