SACE Board hoax letter will be investigated

Last night the SACE Board was made aware of a hoax letter circulated on Facebook that suggested there was a breach in the Biology examination, held on Monday 6 November.

The fake letter was published on SACE Board letterhead and included a copied signature of the Acting Chief Executive Jan Raymond.

It suggested that there was a serious breach in the Biology examination and that every student would need to re-sit this examination.

The SACE Board would like to reassure students that this letter was a hoax and there was no breach, and so no student will need to re-sit this examination.

All other examinations will continue as per the published timetable.

The SACE Board views this hoax as a very serious issue and is investigating its origin.
