# Online submission of assessment materials for selected Stage 2 subjects

You are receiving this correspondence as you have been identified as teaching at least one of the nine Stage 2 subjects selected for the online submission of assessment materials in 2017.

This letter contains important information about the online submission process, including links to online resources, such as frequently asked questions (FAQs) and instructional training videos.

<u>Please note</u>: a separate communication will be sent to school ICT staff this afternoon to assist them in supporting teachers with the online submission process at the school level. <u>Access the school ICT staff letter</u>.

## **Overview of the online submission process**

As communicated previously, the move to online submissions is part of the SACE Board's efforts to modernise its key functions and procedures progressively over the next five years.

In its 2016 consultation with schools, the SACE Board learned that students of the selected subjects are already submitting most of their work electronically to the teacher. Therefore, it makes sense for the teachers to upload the student work directly into Schools Online, for the purposes of marking and moderation.

The table below outlines which subjects have been selected for online submission in 2017.
