


Electronic Examinations


Technical readiness

Working with school IT staff to run tests to validate the school's technical capabilities, including the installation of the SACE Examination Browser.



Familiarisation

Communicating with and exposing students and teachers to the features. of the electronic examination.



Working with a range of stakeholders, schools, committees, and working groups to support schools to get ready.



Training

Providing Invigilators, SACE Coordinators and IT support staff, with the knowledge and skills needed to administer the examination.



Final readiness period



Undertaking final preparations ahead of electronic examinations to ensure technical and change readiness.



Practice window

Providing schools with an opportunity to test their technical and change readiness in preparation for electronic examinations. School staff will put into practice the knowledge and skills needed to administer electronic examinations in November and students receive an exam day practice.
