

## Self-directed Community Learning

### Performance requirements

In the interview with the student, the assessor(s) may use the performance checklist(s) as a reference point when constructing questions to elicit the evidence of learning from the student.

After the interview, the assessor(s) use the form(s) to assess the level (Stage 1 and/or 2) at which the evidence is provided, and the number of credits to be awarded.

Students are able to gain a maximum of 90 credits at Stage 1 or Stage 2 across any of the eight areas of learning towards SACE completion.

Students may gain Stage 2 credits without gaining Stage 1 credits in the same area of learning.

Recognition is not granted against the Personal Learning Plan (at Stage 1), the literacy and numeracy requirements, the Research Project (at Stage 2), or the requirement for 60 credits at a 'C' grade or better at Stage 2.
