2011 SACE Completers with VET - baseline data as at 20 January 2012

- Of the students who completed the SACE in 2011 more than 4,600 studied some form of VET
- Based on a distinct qualification count per student, these completers had over 7700 VET 'enrolments' in VET qualifications
- 41.5% of SACE completers who studied VET did so in more than one qualification
- SACE Completers with VET studied VET in a total of 405 different qualifications across over 30 different industry areas.

Number of SACE Completers with a School Based Apprenticeship in 2011

- Over 440 SACE completers were recorded as undertaking a School Based Apprenticeship in 2011
- 54.4% were female and 45.6% were male
- The 440+ school based apprenticeships were across 89 different VET qualifications in 25 different industry areas.

Data assumptions and caveats

- The 2011 data is for students who completed their SACE in 2011 at a South Australian contact school and includes 2011 mid-year data
- Baseline data takes into consideration the 'old' system of calculating VET in SACE pre-2011 where this is present (including embedded VET) as well as new VET in SACE
- Baseline statistics are based on a distinct count of industry area or qualification per student
- Not every VET qualification has an Industry Area recorded against it. Records with a 'null' Industry Area have been excluded from this dataset.

- Not every VET qualification has an Industry Area recorded against it. Records with a 'null' Industry Area have been excluded from this dataset. Pre-2011 comparisons are not available.
