

StudyAdelaide & SACE International Ambassador Program 2024 FAQ

Who is StudyAdelaide?

<u>StudyAdelaide</u> is a South Australian government destination marketing and student support agency, working with over 50 education partners.

Who is SACE International?

The SACE Board is a statutory authority (government agency) of the Government of South Australia that provides the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE). <u>SACE International</u> is the international department of the SACE Board and oversees schools delivering the SACE outside of Australia.

What is this program?

This introductory program tour gives participants the opportunity to experience first-hand the education and lifestyle opportunities, Adelaide as a study destination has to offer students. The program will include visit to our three public universities and TAFE SA campuses, professional development program, workshop with SACE International. The program will also provide attendees with a working knowledge of South Australian education system which are very important to SACE International schools in growing enrolments.

What is included in the Ambassador Program?

Return economy flights from your home country to Adelaide, accommodation, most meals, all transport requirements and amazing education and tourism experiences.

Travel expenses such as travel insurance, visa fees, passport renewal costs, transport outside official program and incidental expenses are not included.

What are the dates of the program?

The program dates are from Saturday 15th June 2024 to Friday 21st June 2024. These dates are inclusive of travel dates.

How will flights be arranged?

StudyAdelaide will manage, book, and pay for your flight bookings via our selected travel agent. You will be consulted through this process. Flights will be return flights from your home country to Adelaide only. Travel to other states within Australia is not permitted under this program.

Do I need travel insurance?

It is strongly recommended that you have travel insurance, which is your responsibility to arrange.





Will StudyAdelaide help me complete my visitor visa application?

No. You will need to apply for your own tourist visa, however, StudyAdelaide will provide a letter in support of your visa application. We also ask that you apply for your visa application as soon as possible.

Where will I be staying?

StudyAdelaide will arrange accommodation on single occupancy basis for the duration of the program. You will be provided with your accommodation details closer to the program date. Free Wi-Fi is included at the hotel.

What can I expect?

The program will involve visits and networking with our three public universities (Flinders University, the University of Adelaide and University of South Australia), TAFE SA, SA government schools and other institution partners.

The famil also includes activities to highlight the vibrant lifestyle and career opportunities the city offers students.

The itinerary commences with an arrival flight into Adelaide on 15th June 2024 and includes:

- Welcome reception
- Interactive visits to institutions
- · Interactive day with the SACE Board
- Professional development workshop
- Exciting touring/tourism activities
- Time to explore Adelaide on your own or with others

Itinerary details, including dress codes, will be sent once your participation is confirmed. Please note that the itinerary is subject to change.

Are all elements of the program compulsory?

Yes, the program has been carefully considered to provide you with a well-rounded experience of Adelaide as a destination for international students. We will allow for some free time in the program but due to the investment of time and budget that has gone into the program, it is expected that you attend all aspects of the program.

Are there any COVID-19 requirements to enter Australia?

The Australian Government does <u>not</u> currently have any COVID-19 requirements in place for travellers entering and departing Australia.

COVID-19 however continues to pose a health risk in Australia and overseas. The Australian Government strongly encourages wearing masks and being vaccinated.

You will still need to check that you meet the requirements of your airline, your home country, and any countries you transit through.





What happens if I contract COVID or get sick during the program?

If you test positive during the famil, you will need to follow the advice from <u>SA Health</u>. There is no mandatory quarantine or isolation required if you test positive for COVID-19.To protect the health of others, we will request for you to avoid contact with the group until your acute symptoms have cleared. The StudyAdelaide team will be there to assist you and make your stay as comfortable as possible.

If you require medical attention during the program, it will be covered by your travel insurance. It is your responsibility to arrange travel insurance before travelling to Australia.

Can I visit other cities in Australia before or after the program?

No.

Your visa support letter from StudyAdelaide will only cover the dates of travel that you will be in Adelaide.
